TEMPLE UNIVERSITY NAME CHANGE PROJECT

Have a team of law students support you each step of the way through the legal name change process. Note: One in-person meeting is usually required.

Process

- 1. Email templelawnamechangeproject@gmail.com with your request.
- 2. You will receive an auto-response that lets you know about the service and will direct you to fill out the intake form.
- 3. Expect to meet with your assigned law students at least once to review the petition they've drafted for you.
